  1. **Walking/Bike Path Proposal for Village of Kirkland via Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP)** – President Block turned the floor over to Jeff Jacobson from Fehr-Graham. Jeff explained to the Board of Trustees the proposed project that will be submitted for funding through the Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP) 2021 cycle. The proposed project will provide a paved multi-use pathway from Behnke Park to the corner of Kennedy Drive and Forest Drive in the Village of Kirkland. The project is anticipated to be the first phase of a multi-phase program to increase connectivity of pathway facilities within the Village to Pottawattamie Park just north of Village limits.
