Monday, June 15, 2026**

OFFICIAL MINUTES

- I. **Call to Order** – President Block called the Board of Trustee Regular meeting to order at 7:20 P.M.
- II. **Roll call** - Members answering present as follows: Trustee Marshall, Trustee Fruit, Trustee Chambers, Trustee Michener and Trustee Benes. Trustee Ziegler was absent. President Block, Village Clerk Scidmore, Police Chief Davenport and Public Works Supervisor Stark were present.
- III. **Comments from the Audience** –
 - a. Ron Brown shared his concern with the flood issues due to Bull Run Creek.
- IV. **New Business** –
 - a. **Approval of Ordinance / Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2026 and Ending on April 30, 2027** – President Block asked for a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2026-12 / Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2026 and Ending on April 30, 2027. Trustee Benes made a motion to approve the Ordinance No. 2026-12 / Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2026 and Ending on April 30, 2027, with a 2nd by Trustee Michener. On a roll call vote Trustees Marshall, Fruit, Chambers, Michener and Benes voted yes. Trustee Ziegler was absent. Motion carried.
 - b. **Discussion of Village of Kirkland Financial Opportunities** – President Block opened the floor for discussion. Trustee Fruit mentioned that in the memo received from Village Attorney Matthew it was suggested that the board contact our bank about getting a consolidated loan in order to combine several loans into one. There was also discussion about “Bank Placement” and what that entails. Village Clerk Scidmore will contact Resource Bank to inquire about a consolidated loan.
 - c. **Discuss / Approval of Annual Kirkland Lions Club 4th of July Fireworks Donation** – President Block said that due to the financial situation of the Village he recommended that the board do an “In-Kind” donation of the Police Department and Public Work’s staff time on behalf of the Annual Kirkland Lions Club 4th of July Fireworks in lieu of a financial donation this year. All the Trustees in attendance agreed.
 - d. **Discuss /Approval of Cancellation of July 6, 2026 Regular Board Meeting** – President Block explained that due to the 4th of July holiday schedules are tight that week and he recommended the cancellation of the Monday July 6, 2026 board meeting and reconvene on the 3rd Monday, July 20, 2026 at 7:00 P.M. Trustee Fruit made a motion to cancel the July 6, 2026 Regular Meeting with a 2nd by Chambers. All in favor. Trustee Ziegler was absent. Motion carried.
- V. **Adjourn to Executive Session** – At 7:58 P.M., President Block ask for a motion to adjourn to Executive Session for Appointment, Compensation, Discipline, Discharge and/or Performance of Specific Employees [pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(1)]. Trustee Fruit made a motion to adjourn to Executive Session, with a 2nd by Trustee Michener. On a roll call vote Trustees Benes, Marshall, Fruit, Chambers and Michener voted yes. Trustees Ziegler was absent. Motion carried.

- VI. **Return back to Regular Session from Executive Session** –President Block called the Board of Trustee Regular Meeting back to order at 9:09 P.M.

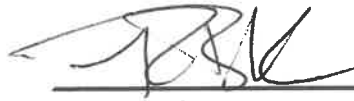
