

ORDINANCE 2026-09

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 73, SCHEDULE II OF THE VILLAGE
CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF KIRKLAND, DEKALB COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
REGARDING A YIELD INTERSECTION**

WHEREAS, the Village of Kirkland, DeKalb County, Illinois, is a non-home rule municipality as contemplated by the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois and statutes; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Kirkland have determined that it is in the interest of public safety to regulate traffic at the intersection of Fifth Street and Railroad Alley; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Kirkland have determined that it is in the interest of public safety to regulate traffic at the intersection of Fifth Street and Railroad Alley; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that vehicles traveling on Railroad Alley should be required to yield the right-of-way to traffic traveling on Fifth Street.

SECTION 1: Amendment of Chapter 73, Schedule II.

Chapter 73, Schedule II, entitled "Yield Intersections," is hereby amended by adding the following entry:

Intersection	Street to Yield Right-of-Way
Fifth Street and Railroad Alley	The traffic on Railroad Alley to yield

SECTION 2. Installation of Sign.

The Village's authorized officials are hereby authorized and directed to install and maintain appropriate traffic control signage consistent with this Ordinance, the Village Code, and the Illinois Vehicle Code.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.

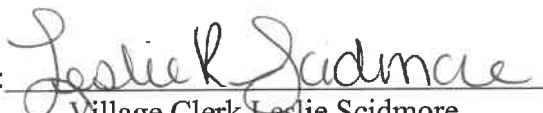
