

**ORDINANCE NO. 2026- 06**

**An Ordinance Authorizing the Disposal of Items of Personal Property Owned by the Village of Kirkland**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Kirkland is authorized by statute to dispose of certain items of property, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4;

**WHEREAS**, it is the opinion of the Village Board of Village of Kirkland, <sup>DEKALB</sup> ~~McHenry~~ County, Illinois, that it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Village to retain the certain property owned by the Village and that such property is obsolete, damaged, and/or beyond use:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by Board of Trustees of the Village as follows:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village Board authorizes the disposal of the following property by auction, sale, salvage, or disposal:

SECTION 2: Pursuant to said Section 5/11-76-4, the Village is (1) authorized and directed to sell the personal property described in Section 1 of this Ordinance, with or without advertising the sale, or (2) to convert that personal property into some other form that is useful to the Village by using the material in the personal property, (3) convey or turn in any of the personal property as part payment on a new purchase of any similar article, or (4) dispose of the item if the item is beyond use.


SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval. Passed this 16 day of MARCH, 2026, by a roll call vote as follows:
